


Principal's Report

Applications now open for the 2020 Kat Muscat Fellowship

Express Media is honoured to open submissions for the 2020 Kat Muscat Fellowship to develop young writers and editors from around Australia.

The annual **Kat Muscat Fellowship** offers professional development up to the value of \$5,000 for an editorial project or work of writing by a young person of an underrepresented gender. The Fellowship aims to continue Kat's legacy and further develop the future of defiant and empathic young Australian writers and editors.

We are delighted that in the fifth year of the Kat Muscat Fellowship, the amount awarded to the annual recipient has increased to \$5,000," says Veronica Sullivan, chair of the Custodial Committee of the Kat Muscat Fellowship. This allows the Fellowship to continue supporting the feminist voices of the future, recognising the crucial role that development and mentorship play in the careers of emerging writers and editors."

Ana Maria Gomides, the 2018 Kat Muscat Fellow, says: 'Defiance, feminism, empathy. To have those three values – Kat's mantra – recognised in my work was already a huge honour. Little did I know of the unconditional and ongoing support that the Fellowship would provide. As any chronically ill person will tell you, balancing work and health in an ableist world can be near impossible. The Muscat family and Express Media were not only incredibly accommodating of my capacity, but unwavering in their belief of it.'

Liana Skrzypczak, the 2019 Kat Muscat Fellow, says: 'Without the support of the Kat Muscat Fellowship, I would not have been able to conduct on-site research into the setting of [my novel] The Lore of Jeju. I am a writer whose themes have always been deeply connected to setting and place. This Fellowship allowed me to engage all five senses authentically and to ensure Shin-young's story isn't a skeleton without a heart.'

Kat Muscat was a brilliant young mind of the Australian writing community, whose formidable talent was demonstrated through her incisive writing and perceptive editing. Kat was an integral part of Express Media for many years, before becoming Editor of Voiceworks from 2012 to 2014. Throughout her 10 years with Express Media, Kat helped to shape the career of young writers and editors from all around Australia.

The Kat Muscat Fellow is selected by the **Custodial Committee of The Kat Muscat Fellowship**, which includes members of Express Media's board and staff, the Muscat family and appointed community members. Past recipients include **Bri Lee** (2016), **Fury** (2017), **Ana Maria Gomides** (2018), and **Liana Skrzypczak** (2019).

The Fellowship is made possible with the generous support of the community and the Muscat family.

Applicants must be a person of an underrepresented gender or sex, and be aged 16 to 30 at the commencement of the Fellowship. Applications are open now until 11.59pm AEDT, Sunday 12 January 2020.


