# What is different about Year 10?

## Acceleration

You have the option of applying to study a Year 11 subject.

This would result in you obtaining a Unit 1,2 subject in Year 10 and then possibly a Unit 3,4 subject in Year 11.

Why? Challenge, interest, start obtaining credit for VCE early, end up with 6 Unit 3,4 subjects instead of the standard 5. Completing a two-year TAFE Certificate by the end of Year 11.



### Criteria for acceleration

You need to have demonstrated:

- ✓ A strong work ethic able to cope with the increased work demands of VCE/VET. This includes in class and also the homework requirements.
- ✓ Good skills in the chosen subject. Are you an Honour student in that subject at Year 9?
- ✓ Mature behaviour in class and the ability to work alongside older students.
- Approval from the subject learning area.


