Choosing to be at school and choosing to learn and so improve our future lives is a positive and clever choice.






Our Year 10's are talking about.....

Looking forward to their Work Experience Program


I am looking forward to experiencing some of the different areas in Allied Health Care. I am hoping to get a glimpse of what a future in these areas might look like.



This includes the VBA fees and local court fees. If you are registering 3 or more children, you will receive a \$30 rebate from the ADBA.
