What they are really enjoying at the moment.

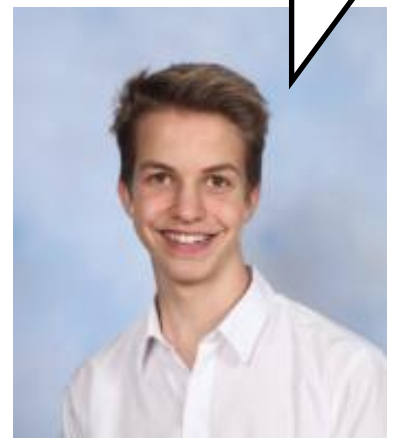
Madison is really enjoying her Physical Education classes this term. When asked why, she explained that she really likes her teacher and she is having lots of fun.

2024 Info on Young Carer Bursary Program

The Young Carer Bursary Program supports young carers to return or continue their education. Young carers are people up to 25 years old who provide unpaid care and support to family members or friends who have a disability, mental illness, chronic condition, mental illness, an alcohol or other drug issue or who are frail aged. That is - you look after your folks, siblings, other family members in a significant way.

The program offers 1592 bursaries of \$3,768 each year to assist young carers with education needs and resources.

To register as a young carer and apply for the bursary visit the Young Carers Network website. Start your application now so that you have plenty of time to finish it before the deadline. Applications close on 12 September 2023.

Young carers must apply each year to be assessed for a bursary. It makes no difference whether you complete your application on the first day or the final day as all Applications will be reviewed after the closing date (12 September 2023). All Applications go to the Independent Assessment Panel for Review and this process can take up to 16 weeks.

We'll email you after the assessment process to let you know the outcome of your application, and if you're conditionally approved what to do next.
