

Choosing to be at school and choosing to learn and so improve our future lives is a positive and clever choice.



## We are Going to Meet Dr Jane Goodal!

GUARDIANS

Five members from our student Green Team, 'The Guardians of the Earth' will give a private presentation to Dr Jane Goodall at the Melbourne Museum on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. This is an incredible honour for our College as we are one of only five Victorian schools to be selected.

Dr Jane Goodall is a legendary conservationist from England and she is currently on a Global 'Reasons for Hope' Tour to celebrate 60 years of conservation work.



Jane's discovery in 1960 that chimpanzees make and use tools and it's not just humans who are complex thinkers, is considered one of the greatest achievements in Science this century.



It's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for our students and we were thrilled to learn that we had been selected last week.

Ours students will tell Jane all about the College's major rehabilitation project along the UT Creek riparian zone at the back of Briggs Oval.

We will talk about our collaboration with the Shire of Murrindindi and the Upper Goulburn Landcare Network and our incredible Planet Ark Grant of \$3000 which has allowed Euroa Arboretum to set aside 850 native trees, shrubs and sedges for us to plant in July. The focus of the presentation will be how the rehabilitation will provide habitat for our local native animals.


Mitch enjoys learning in his Science class, however he also says that Mr Woof is really fun to be around.




